Australian Historic Motoring Federation: AGM was held 20th September in Brisbane. Elected committee; President – Neil Athorn (Vic); Vice President – Eric Hutton (NT); Secretary – Christine Stevens (QLD); Treasurer – David Marshall-Martin (NSW). AGM discussed in General Business.

General Business:

1. **MG Car Club Sunshine Coast.**

To confirm decision made at August Committee Meeting that MGCC Sunshine Coast become an affiliated club. **Moved:** Graham Bristow, **Seconded:** Jim Scott. **Carried.**

2. **AUSTRALIAN HISTORIC MOTORING FEDERATION AGM:**

CC President gave a 'run down' of the agenda items and elaborated on the AHMF President's report: Thanks extended to Christine Stevens for organising the AGM; Robert Shannon Foundation; AHMF website; Exporting of historical machinery and vehicles (there is a group in the process of being formed to approach Federal Govt to minimize or stop this trade); National Motoring Heritage Day – thanks extended to AOMC for the poster, lamented lack of national coverage by media; Taxation – a submission will be made to the Henry Enquiry (taxation review) that 'hobby' motoring clubs be exempted from tax; Constitution – final amendments; 'Bring Back Bluebird' – AHMF to continue talks with Beaulieu.

3. **ROBERT SHANNON FOUNDATION:**

Eight high quality applications for grants were received by the trustees. The successful applicants were: Matthew Czerba (NSW) restoring a 1916 MAG twin cylinder motorcycle; Thomas Sutherland (VIC) restoring 1929/30 Austin 7; Josiah Gaul (QLD) restoring a Wolseley 24/80 MkII.

4. **COMBINED COUNCIL RALLIES:** 2009 (QVVA at Bribie Island); 2010 (Fraser Coast); **2011- volunteer Club required; 2012 - volunteer Club required..**

5. **S.I.V.S. CONCESSIONAL REGISTRATION:**

a. A circular setting out conditions of use for SIVS registered vehicles has been sent by Qld Transport (QT) to the owners of all SIVS registered vehicles. There is inconsistency in this circular where it refers to the old guidelines, when compared to the new guidelines listed on QT website. QCC to request clarification. (see i. below), and there is lack of definition when referring to "immediate" family (see ii. below).

i. **Retention of club membership:** QCC to request clarification of 'continue to be a condition' to retain membership (in the circular) / 'should' retain membership (in the old guidelines) / and no mention at all (in the new guidelines). **Moved:** Robin Lamb **Seconded:** Albert Budworth **Carried**

ii. **Family use in the context of weddings / formals:** QCC to seek clarification regarding brothers / sisters / 'step children' / partners and their immediate family / same sex relationships **Moved:** Jim Scott **Seconded:** Rick A'bell **Carried**

b. **Vehicle Registration:** Any club member experiencing genuine difficulty with QT over registration of a restored /old / interstate vehicle should contact the Secretary QCC through their club. The QCC *QT Liaison Officer* has established access to QT staffmembers who have the necessary authority to arbitrate in these instances.

- c. **Dating certificate:** A standard dating certificate to be drafted and provided to clubs for their use if they so desire. It was noted that some clubs already have a suitable form.
- d. **Formal Approval for SIVS Use at Combined Council Events:** All QCC events, activities and meetings, which delegates and visitors attend, are approved for SIVS vehicle use.
- e. **Completed SIVS Review:** Re weekend use: LAMA wants QCC to pursue individual use of SIVS vehicles on weekends, particularly for the benefit of geographically isolated clubs that do not have access to the multitude of events that occur in the SE corner of the State and that there be ongoing negotiations with QT regarding weekend use of historic vehicles. **Moved:** Jim Scott (LAMA) **Seconded:** John Green (Mustang) **Carried**
6. **NATIONAL MOTORING HERITAGE DAY – 17th May 2009**
July minutes requested delegates to nominate for a sub-committee to organise activities. There has not been any response. The President expressed disappointment and requested that delegates revisit the request and report back to the November meeting. It was suggested from the floor that a full page flyer be included in the minutes listing events already nominated eg LAMA Swap and Heritage Truck show at Beenleigh.
7. **COUNTRY MEETINGS FOR COMBINED COUNCIL:** Kevin E reported that there has not been any progress. He will discuss with the Secretary, Richard E upon his return from holidays.
8. **COMBINED COUNCIL WEBSITE:** Website is unserviceable and Christine Stevens has agreed to rectify it.
9. **MOTORFEST – COMBINED COUNCIL STALL:** The President suggested that QCC has a small stall at next year's Motorfest to promote club affiliation and its benefits. Secretary to contact RACQ to enquire if they would be receptive.
10. **DATE CLAIMER PROTOCOL:** At the August management meeting a suggestion was made that QCC initiate a 'date claimer protocol' to prevent clashes of event dates on the QCC Events Calendar. After some vigorous discussion the proposal was rejected.
11. **NAME CHANGE PROPOSAL:** President, together with the Committee, has suggested that the QCC change its name to "**QUEENSLAND HISTORIC MOTORING COUNCIL Inc.**" It is proposed that delegates vote on the change of name at the January 2009 meeting. This will happen at the same time as the updated Constitution is finalised. (our current Constitution does not reflect the Dept of Fair Trading model). Motion: That delegates obtain their club's instructions with respect to voting on the proposed name change at the January 2009 meeting. **Moved:** David James **Seconded:** Rick A'bell. **Carried**
12. **IDENTIFICATION OF DELEGATES:** President requested delegates to wear a name badge as a matter of courtesy to encourage interaction between delegates. Wearing of club shirts at QCC GMs was also recommended.

AHMF President's report: Thanked Christine Stevens for organising the AGM; Update on Robert Shannon Foundation; Raised issue of number of exports of historical machinery and vehicles, there is a group in process of being formed to approach Federal Govt to minimize or stop this trade; Reminded all of National Motoring Heritage Day poster produced by AOMC Vic; Raised issue of club taxation (submission to be made to Henry Enquiry (taxation review) that 'hobby' motoring clubs be exempted from tax); AHMF constitution final amendments this meeting; 'Bring Back Bluebird' project and AHMF is to continue talks with Beaulieu.

The QCC *QT Liaison Officer* has established access to QT staff members who have the necessary authority to arbitrate in these instances.
