Reduced age requirement for historic buses

Policy and legislative work required to reduce the age from 30 years to 25 years is progressing and it is estimated that changes will come into effect before June 2018.

Registration fees for SIVS motorcycles

TMR advised that following representations, reduced fees will apply to SIVS registered motorcycles from 1 July 2018.

- Owners will pay \$34.20 for registration a fees, a reduction of \$60.95 compared to the concessional rate of \$94.95
- Renewal registration notices foe eligible motorcycles will be sent out from mid- May for registrations with a due date of 1 July 2018
