AUSTRALIAN HISTORICAL MOTORING FEDERATION REPORT: Presented by Christine Stevens

TRANSPORT and MAIN ROADS REPORT: Presented by Albert Budworth

Overhead cameras photograph sash type seat belts but not lap belts. If you receive an infringement notice for no belt (and this depends on the year vintage of the vehicle) or you're wearing a lap belt only, you are advised to pursue the matter and have it quashed. You can do this by contacting Consolidated Revenue or Dept Transport and Main Roads. Refer Newsletter No 23.

A mobile phone must not be worn on your person, eg in a shirt top pocket; a case where a name tag was photographed as a mobile phone and pursued as an infringement.
